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Résumé de la conférence

Reasoning is a central cognitive skill for both Piaget and H.P. Grice, who called for its characterization as uniquely human cognitive skill. The paper presents some points of comparison between their two views and clarifies how action is central to both. Grice's notion of reasoning entails, however, a different agenda for logic, arguing for an integrated logic of belief and action based on commonly held norms.
